Explanation of Website

In comparison to the original concept ideation, the site itself has been altered slightly, both in concept and layout. We have decided to completely remove the concept of posting 'status bulletins' and event notifications from the website, both due to the complex code involved, and ease of use. The site functionality has changed from a social network to connect and interact with musicians, to a website based directory of musicians in the country. This change of website concept has inevitably caused us to change the design of the main site itself. We decided that it would be easier, and promote a better ease of use, if the user was presented with their own information upon login. This is specifically import upon first login as, in order to sign up, the user only has to include minimal information. Once logged in, they are then shown the option to include information such as Location and a Personal Bio. From there, the only other prime functionality of the website is to search for other users. We decided to make the search bar quite big. This was so that the key functionality of the site is clearly shown. The users are attracted to the bar, and thus use the site for its purpose.

Key Code Description

The code for the website is overall relatively basic in concept. However, there are certain sections that are in need of explanation, and should be highlighted for the purpose of this report.

The register section of the website is all on one page. Following the original example of a HTML Form, its somewhat standard for the form to redirect to another page for the to be processed by PHP. In our registration page (Ref. Code Image Section), we have a simple If Statement asking if whatever is in the username/password field are filled in. If they aren't carry on down to the else, which is the code for the HTML Registration Form. The Form then redirects back to the registration page, however this time the page loads, the Username/Password fields, along with the other necessary fields, are full. Therefore, the PHP on the page (above), runs. This code converts all inputted information into PHP Variables. We then check to see if the username and email inputted are already in the system. In short, if the amount of rows returned, where the inputted username/email is equaled to 1, it is already in use. Next is to make sure the password and confirm password fields match, the password entered is more than 6 characters and make sure there are no spaces in the Username. If all these checks come back with no errors, the code follows down to an Else Statement in which the user is shown a Success Message.

The coding method used in this section is used in various places throughout the website. We called a mysql query by which we selected the username in the database where the username is equalled to the Session Name ¹. Once a username was called, we then checked to see what the row number was. In the form code itself, we gave each field a value (if it already had one). We also disabled the username field, as if the user accidentally left it blank, it would cause multiple errors throughout the website, including not being able to correctly use the query described above.

We also decided to make the location a drop down, in order to control both the locations entered by users and in order to make the Profile pages more aesthetically pleasing. With this, we had dummy options (blank spaces/lines) to separate what was already entered and what was available for the user to input. If the user accidentally attempts to enter one of these values, it returns with the current value.

¹ With regards the Session Name, this was set up upon login so that the user was able to Log in and out and also not be able to access various pages in the site without being logged in. In *verify.php*, we assigned the \$_SESSION variable as equalled to the username which the user logs in with, therefore having a unique and common ID throughout the website for various tasks.

Results.php For Loop

In order to show multiple results for the search result page we used a for loop. Above this excerpt we stated the *\$cnt* variable, which is equaled to number of rows returned from a query asking for the amount of rows containing the search word. The for loop then returns all results up until the amount of results returned. There is also an if statement informing the result page to link to a next page if the results exceeds 10.

If the user finds another user they wish to connect with, the entry on the results page links to profile.php?id=(user_id). This is in order to have one profile page file for all users. Once the user is on the profile.php page, the code calls the id number in the url bar, and thus displays the relevant information from that row.

Notes

- 1. Design, Code and Screenshots detailed on this report may differ from the final draft of files on the testweb2 server. These are only minor design details such as text emphasis and size in certain parts.
- 2. Implementation of a password encryption feature for safely storing passwords in the MySQL database wasn't achievable due to problems in verification in the login page. Therefore this feature was omitted. Please don't include any valuable information when signing up as it is relatively accessible by those with the password or higher access.
- 3. Implementation of multiple instruments was also unachievable to date, as it was low in priority, and the time available near the end of our assignment wasn't enough to effectively work on this feature.
- 4. When accessing the website on testweb2, you will be presented with a file directory, including a folder entitled 'jammer', along with three other junk files. Please click the jammer folder, and you will be directed to the correct website.






